NOTES:

- Of the four ACC elective courses, three at minimum have to be from this group: BUSA 309, 318, 319, 414, 415, 416, 418, 419, or 459.
- Auditing (BUSA 415) may be considered an Ethics focus area course; if not, add an ETH course to this list.
- The CPA license in the state of Hawai'i requires 150 college level credits to be completed, of which 24 have to be Accounting credits (18 have to be upper division 300 or above) and 24 have to be non-Accounting Business credits (all upper division). The additional credits beyond the 120 graduation requirements can be any college level credits (100 level or above). Note that another concentration could be completed which is 18 credits and/or a certificate could be completed which is around 15 credits. For further information about the CPA exam, please meet with your faculty advisor.
 - Please note that students only need 120 credits in order to sit for the CPA exam.
 - Also note that even though BUSA 301, BUSA 348, and BUSA 440 are counted as accounting electives, they do not count towards the 24 accounting credits needed for the CPA license. They are counted as business credits instead.
- For students interested in completing the CPA exams, it is highly suggested that they take the following courses from the Accounting Concentration list: Top list: BUSA 319 and 415. Second best: BUSA 318, 414, 416, 418, and 419.
